LENA GROW & START

Virginia Beach understands children begin learning at birth in all environments: at home, at school, and in the community. GROW and START programs build on brain science which confirms that neural connections are created and reinforced during the ages of 0 – 3 years at rapid rates.



Participated in 30 GROW classrooms **56%** increase in children's Conversational Turns **100%** teachers recommend GROW **96%** teachers report more confident & increased job satisfaction

Participated in START classes 19% increase in Adult Words 107% increase in Shared Book Reading 17% percentile gain in Language Development 85% Graduation Rate 91% families indicate positive changes





By pairing striving first grade readers with caring community volunteer tutors/mentors we assist children in becoming confident, successful readers. Tutors receive intensive training effective in instructional techniques and increasing student engagement. Each month the children are given one free take home book, to build their home library
